ENERGY REDUCTION MEASURES – Proposed New Building

The new building has been planned to replace the existing condemned wooden frame general purpose storage building which was badly damaged last winter by the weight of snow. The sizes of each are almost identical.

At this stage it is proposed to install 9x80watt low voltage lights (1in each bay) in the new structure – and no sockets. These low voltage lights will replace the existing lighting in the condemned building which consists of several (at least 8) 500 watt together with a number of lower voltage lights. From this it can clearly be seen that there will be a massive reduction in CO² emissions which should satisfy Core Policy D of the NYM Local Development Framework – well in excess of 10%. As well as reducing emissions it will also have a beneficial effect on the energy bill on the farm.
