Please find attached a revised drawing of the proposed elevations and first floor layout.

The comments made by the NYMNP have been taken into account. The proposed elevations and first floor plan have been amended to show the revised dormers plus information in respect of the timber rafters.

The drawing now shows:-

- The ridge line
- The position of the rafters in the w.c.
- The revised position of the dormer serving the w.c. to reduce the impact on the roof structure.
- Revised size of dormer facing the yard (North West Elevation)
- Reduced height of dormer window roofs to South East. They have been amended downward from the ridge line.

The requirement for the dormer to the w.c. has been questioned. This has been proposed are they are currently no bathing facilities at first floor level and the client would intends to install a shower cubicle. The extra room provided by the dormer is therefore crucial.

The dormer window facing the yard (North West) is as per the previous drawings showing the reduced scale/size initially asked for by the NYMNP officer. A width of 1.5m was stated in discussions and this has been met. From review of old drawings of the yard and the surrounding buildings, the previous dormer is shown as 5ft wide. This equates to 1.52m. The previous window was 4ft high equating to 1.219m. The proposed window is 900mm high which is a significant reduction.






