Many thanks for your valued enquiry.

We have based our costing for the replacment of your windows at Grosmont Chapel upon the following specification:

Supply and fit of our Insulead units which comprise of a full 28mm unit made up of Pilkington K optiwhite toughened on the inside pane with Pilkington Optiwhite toughened on the outside using Swiss V warm edge spacer bar. Kiln glass is optional and where requested the frosted glass has been accounted of. Our fixed frames are fully drained and thermally broken. The openers that we manufacture are made out of stainless steel, fully weather stripped, thermally broken and powder coated to any RAL colour. Our openers are in the process of being energy rated and indications are that we will achieve an 'A' rating. No modification to the stonework is required so it is ideal for heritage buildings and essentially once our system is installed it is virtually maintenance free as there is nothing to paint etc. The U value for this specification is 1.7. For a small additional cost we can fill the units with Argon gas which would lower the U value to 1.5 if necessary.

#### The cost for:

6 of opening stainless steel casements (these can be top openers as requested)

12 of Insulead fixed units for the lancet windows

2 of Insulead fixed units on the west elevation

1 of Insulead fixed unit on the east elevation

would be £ 13,992 (plus VAT if applicable)

With regards to the door on the East elevation we think that we may be able to offer a solution but this is something that we need to look at in more detail and will get back to you as soon as possible.

Should you wish to proceed with the work we do require a 30% deposit to secure the order, 30% upon manufacture, 30% prior to delivery and 10% upon practical completion. Please note that simple and safe access to both sides of the windows is required but has not been allowed for.
