Dear Mr Hill,

Planning Permission NYM/2012/0601/FL - discharge of planning conditions - Doves Nest- exploration drilling

I am writing to formally request discharge of the planning conditions relating to the above application and submit a minor amendment for condition 2.

As discussed in the York Potash Project Management Group Meeting on 3rd October 2012, we would like to submit an updated Hydrological Risk Assessment to the one which was originally submitted on 24th August 2012 as a minor amendment to condition 2. A copy of the updated Hydrological Risk Assessment is enclosed.

Condition 3 requires the submission of the final drilling programme to the local authority in writing for approval prior to the commencement of drilling on site. A copy of the final Drilling Method Statement is enclosed for the purpose of discharging condition 3.

The site will operate as follows in order to comply with condition 5;

In order to prevent mud, grit and other detritus from being carried onto the public highway from the site, as required by condition 5, the site operators/contractors propose to use the same methods as have been successfully incorporated on the previous drilling sites. They will provide an electrically operated jet-wash so that drivers can clean the underside and wheels of the vehicles before they depart the site.

This system has proven successful in the past and we trust that it will be acceptable in this instance.

An updated Traffic Management Plan was submitted to the authority on the 19th October 2012 following advice from the Highways Authority. Following this, condition 6 was verbally discharged by Peter Jones and we have been informed that this has been noted on the file for this application.


