This is an appeal for an application decided before 1 October 2013, therefore our Statement of Case will be submitted 6 weeks after registration.

Our grounds of appeal are as follows: Noise is not considered to be an issue due to the limited use, which will be shown in a noise assessment to accompany the Statement of Case. Environmental Health raised no objection to the proposal.

Regarding the materials and colour of the proposed new building, this can be conditioned within any planning permission by the Local Authority and is not too dissimilar to agricultural buildings.

The right of way will not be materially affected as the proposed is only an occasional use.

There are no SPA's or SSSI's within 2km of the closest boundary of the proposed airstrip. There are 2 SSSI sites situated within 3 km of the site and the SPA is approximately 6 km away. These sites are not adjacent or close to the proposed development and the coniferous woodland surrounding the proposed airstrip is likely to attenuate the majority of the noise associated with the development. There will be no low level flying across the designated areas. Natural England raised no objection to the proposal.
