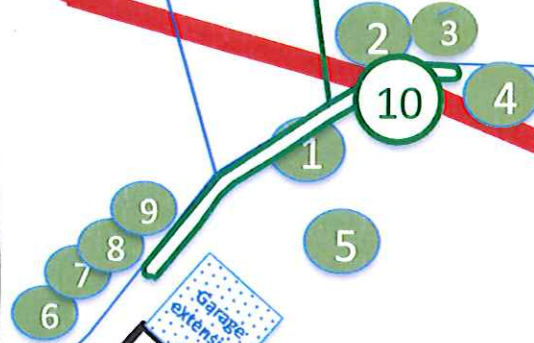
Existing post & rail fence with wire mesh

Leylandii hedge  
1.7 – 2 m high  
0.75 m deep

10 – 20m high,  
0.12-0.5m trunk

### New Planting

**New Hedge:** random mixed hawthorn, blackthorn and holly at about 40 cm centres, slightly staggered with gap to avoid the existing oak(1) and larger spacing to accommodate the new willow (10). The hedge will be allowed to grow to about 1.5 m. The south western end of the hedge is limited by the roots from ashes 6 & 7.

**10** Goat Willow (potentially damp area)

Moor Lodge

- ① Oak 5.7m high 4m spread, 0.14m trunk
- ② Alder, multistem, 6.5m high, 0.15m max trunk
- ③ Alder, 5m high, 0.08m trunk
- ④ Hazel, 6.5m high, 3.8m spread, 0.17m trunk
- ⑤ Chamaecyparis, 5.6m high, 3.6m spread
- ⑥ Ash, multistem, 6.5m high, 0.15m trunk, poor
- ⑦ Ash, multistem, 6 m high, 0.15m trunk, poor
- ⑧ Ash, multistem, 6m high, 0.12m trunk, poor
- ⑨ Ash, multistem, 4.5m high, 0.10m trunk, poor
