With regard to the above property and an application for new shed, replacement and movement of oil tank and replacement of some windows with slimline double glazing.

Please find enclosed the additional documentation you have requested.

- A copy of the site from the ordnance survey map we received on purchase.
- Photos of the existing windows we are looking to replace in accordance with the details already provided.
- Heritage statement. This is brief as the oil tank and shed wont affect the actual building and will be out of sight. The windows will just be replacement of some and will look exactly the same, just with slimline glass and the ones that your officer felt were too chunky and were recent additions will be replaced with more appropriate ones as per the original application and as discussed with your officer.
- From reading the notes i don't believe a design access statement is required as we aren't doing any development and there wont be any changes to the appearance of the building. It is all rather confusing and complicated so if there is something you need from us perhaps you might be able to assist in that regard and apologies if i have missed it. However, from reading it myself i am not really sure how it applies.
- I have signed the form for agricultural holdings as we do not have a certificate and are not registered.
- I enclose photos and measurements of the proposed oil tank and drawings provided by the joiner for the proposed shed including details of materials to be used, the base would be a concrete base.
- There are trees surrounding the proposed site for the shed, which we chose to screen the shed so as to be out of sight, however, no trees need to be removed for the shed as we chose the size to fit in exactly to an existing space so i am advised a tree survey is therefore not required.
