In addition these sites may not be of sufficient quality to qualify as a SINC but are still likely to be of higher ecological quality than other land in the area.

Yorkshire Wildlife Trust Reserves

There are no Yorkshire Wildlife Trust Reserves within the search area.

Species data search

Enclosed is a list of notable and protected species found within the search area together with a spreadsheet listing the species records found, for example Great Crested Newt, Dark Green Fritillary and European Water Shrew. Please note that a lack of survey information for any particular area or taxonomic group does not necessarily mean that there is no nature conservation interest present and I would therefore recommend that a site survey is carried out in order to assess any ecological interest that might be present before proceeding with the development.

Also, in addition to the records shown on the enclosed sheet, there are records within the search area held by the North Yorkshire Bat Group. For further information on these records, you should contact the North Yorkshire Bat Group directly, contact details for which are given below.

One particular point to bear in mind is that many bridges in North Yorkshire provide good opportunities for bats and support bat roosts. Please consult the North Yorkshire Bat Group regarding this aspect if the proposal is likely to require working close to or within the structure of any bridge. Bats are European Protected Species under the Conservation (Natural Habitats &c.) Regulations 1994. As you are probably aware, should a proposal be likely to affect or disturb bats and/or their roosts and therefore require derogation from the Regulations, a licence application to the Wildlife Licensing Unit, Natural England, is required in advance of the works commencing. 4.3 Vulnerability

The value of the North York Moors in providing suitable habitat for breeding merlin and golden plover is dependent on the moorland management that is carried out by farmers and gamekeepers to maintain the moorland plant communities and grouse populations. The most vulnerable plant communities are the heaths and mires which are susceptible to overgrazing, gripping and too frequent heather burning leading to species impoverishment and a loss of structural diversity. A lack of keeping and undergrazing on some moors has resulted in large areas of undermanaged old heather lacking structural diversity which reduces the suitability of the habitat for merlin and golden plover. This is being addressed by looking at payments for positive heather management, such as cutting and burning. The majority of the site is being managed in a desirable way with pressures being largely restricted to small areas.

The site lies entirely within the North York Moors National Park.

The international importance of the bird assemblage is enhanced by the presence of the following breeding species listed on Annex 1 of the EU Birds Directive: merlin, peregrine, hen harrier, golden plover and short-eared owl.

The site supports the following species which are listed as Red Data Birds in Britain: merlin, peregrine, hen harrier, golden plover, red grouse, curlew and redshank. Red Data Birds are those species which are internationally endangered, vulnerable or rare. Snipe, short-eared owl, whinchat, wheatear, ring ouzel and lapwing are being considered as candidate Red Data Birds because their populations are declining or their status is uncertain.

The site incorporates May Moss SSSI, Fylingdales SSSI and part of Tripsdale SSSI. The site abuts, but does not overlap, Newtondale SSSI, Farndale SSSI, Hole of Horcum SSSI, Broughton Bank SSSI, Beck Hole SSSI, Scar End Wood SSSI, Botton Head SSSI, Hill House Nab SSSI, Castle Beck and Scar Woods SSSI, Biller Howe Dale SSSI and Fairy Call Beck SSSI.

Description and Reasons for Notification:

The North York Moors contain the largest continuous tract of heather moorland in England. The site is of national importance for its mire and heather moorland vegetation communities and of international importance for its breeding bird populations, particularly merlin and golden plover.

The site is situated in north-east Yorkshire and lies between the towns of Whitby and Scarborough to the east; Pickering and Helmsley to the south; Northallerton and Stokesley to the west and Loftus and Guisborough to the north. The moors are generally low-lying with the majority of the plateaux elevated to between 150 m and 300 m. The maximum elevation is 545 m on Urra Moor in the west. The elevation decreases towards the south and east.

The site consists of the four main moorland blocks within the North York Moors National Park. There are also five smaller outlying areas that lie close to, but do not join, the main blocks. The largest continuous moorland block is centrally placed within the site and consists of a series of moorland plateaux intersected by valleys. The block is delineated by Bilsdale to the west, Newtondale to the east and Eskdale to the North. The south side is marked by the edge of the moors as they grade into the lowland of the Vale of Pickering. The other three moorland blocks are separated from the central block by valleys and are situated to the west, north and east of it. The western block stretches from Bilsdale to Kewick and Thimbleby Moors which mark the western edge of the moors and the site. The northern block is separated off from the central block by the Esk valley and lies between the northern edge of the National Park and the River Esk. The eastern block is separated by the narrow valley of Newtondale and stretches to the eastern edge of Brow Moor where the site boundary lies within half a mile of the north east coast. The smaller outliers are scattered around the edges of the main moorland blocks and are generally low lying.

Vegetation Communities:

The vegetation displays a transition between blanket bog and dry heath land and supports diverse and extensive upland plant communities.

The moorland plateaux are dominated by dry heath on the central and western moors and wet heath and mire communities on the northern and eastern moors. The plateaux are defined by a number of valleys, the sides of which support extensive strands of bracken and small areas of native woodland. Acid grasslands occur along some of the moorland edges.

Moorland plateaux:

Dry heath covers over half the site and forms the main vegetation type on the western, southern and central moors where the soil is free draining and only a thin peat layer exists. The dry heath is dominated by heather *Calluna vulgaris* and wavy hair-grass *Deschampsia flexuosa* almost to the exclusion of other species, although bilberry *Vaccinium myrtillus* becomes more dominant on the steeper slopes. Bell heather *Erica cinerea* is also found on well drained areas throughout the site, often fringing the sides of tracks and roads. On slopes where bracken *Pteridium aquilinum* has been controlled by spraying, bilberry predominates and cowberry *Vaccinium vitis-idaea* is also frequent.

Wet heath is the second most extensive vegetation type on the site and is predominantly found on the eastern and northern moors where the soil is less free draining. On Fylingdales and Goathland Moors wet heath is the dominant vegetation type, with dry heath being largely confined to the driest soils on the hill tops and ridges. Areas of wet heath tend to be dominated by heather with cross-leaved heath *Erica tetralix* becoming dominant in wetter areas. Purple moor-grass *Molinia caerulea* and heath rush *Juncus squarrosus* are also common within this community. In the wettest stands bog mosses *Sphagnum compactum* and *S. tenellum* and *Dicranum* moss *Dicranum scoparium* occur.

Blanket mire occurs in small amounts along the main watershed of the high moors where deep peat has accumulated. These areas are dominated by heather and cross-leaved heath with

frequent hare's-tail cotton grass *Eriophorum vaginatum* and common cotton grass *E. angustifolium*. The largest area of blanket mire occurs at the northern end of Bransdale.

Grassy mires occur in small peripheral stands on most moors, but form one of the main vegetation communities on the low lying Newton Mulgrave and Ugthorpe Moors and also form large stands on lower lying areas of Danby Low Moor. These areas are often dominated by purple moor-grass with frequent tormentil *Potentilla erecta* and cross-leaved heath.

Wetter mires support the richest bog vegetation and include species such as bog asphodel *Narthecium ossifragum*, bog mosses *Sphagnum* spp., cloudberry *Rubus chamaemorus* and bog rosemary *Andromeda polifolia*. The latter two species are found only on the raised bog at May Moss.

Moorland edge:

Much of the moorland edge is dominated by bracken *Pteridium aquilinum*. These areas are generally species-poor, but in places support scarcer species such as chickweed wintergreen *Trientalis europaea* and dwarf cornel *Cornus suecica*.

Small areas of acid grassland occur on the periphery of the moorland. These grasslands are dominated by mat grass *Nardus stricta* and heath bedstraw *Galium saxatile* on the wetter areas and sheep's fescue *Festuca ovina* and common bent *Agrostis capillaris* on better drained soils. On unenclosed moorland these grasslands grade into heath with the presence of bilberry and heather.

Valley sides and streams:

Flushes occur along seepage lines and stream courses across the moors. Soft rush *Juncus effusus* and sharp-flowered rush *Juncus acutiflorus* dominate over a field layer of mosses such as *Sphagnum recurvum*, *S. auriculatum* and *Polytrichum commune*. These flushes tend to be species-poor, but the nationally scarce creeping forget-me-not *Myosotis stolonifera* can be found in acid moorland streams and shallow pools.

There are also occasional base-rich flushes which support a variety of short sedges *Carex* spp., herbs and mosses and plants such as common butterwort *Pinguicula vulgaris*. These flushes tend to be restricted to small areas on steep valley sides where beds of limestone lie close the surface.

The flush communities make up only a small area of the site, but are an essential part of the moorland habitat particularly because they support rich invertebrate populations which are an important food source for moorland birds.

Woodland:

Woodland is restricted to small areas along gills and the moorland edge is mostly dominated by oaks *Quercus* Spp., and birches *Betula* spp. These woods have a ground flora of bilberry and wavy hair-grass and occasionally common cow-wheat *Melampyrum pratense*. Along streams, narrow bands of alder *Alnus glutinosa* woodland occur with ash *Fraxinus excelsior* and herbs such as yellow pimpernel *Lysimachia nemorum*. The margins of lower moors support scrub in which common gorse *Ulex europaeus* and bramble *Rubus fruticosus* agg., are present.

Natural regeneration on some of the peripheral moors, where grazing and burning pressures are low, has resulted in the presence of scattered trees including oak, birch and, in places, Scots pine *Pinus sylvestris* over an understorey of dry heath. Juniper *Juniperus communis* is locally

rare and exists only as single shrubs or small clusters in a few remote gills and moor edges where burning is absent.

Birds:

The site supports a nationally important assemblage of moorland breeding birds including merlin, golden plover, snipe, curlew, redshank, whinchat, ring ouzel, hen harrier, peregrine and short-eared owl. The populations of breeding merlin and golden plover are of international importance.

Areas of tall heather are favoured by breeding merlin, short-eared owl and hen harrier while the moorland burning and grazing regime provides the varied structure required by red grouse and waders such as golden plover and curlew.

The grassy and rushy edges of the moor provide habitat for breeding snipe, redshank and lapwing. Whinchat also nest on the moorland edge in grassland and bracken beds. Ring ouzels frequent sheltered gill sides and rock out-crops whilst wheatear nest in walls and rocky screes.

Peregrine breed in small numbers on the moor and favour nest sites in disused quarries and crags along the moorland edge.

The site is very wet and vulnerable to both human and livestock pressure. However, the present management agreement with English Nature is preventing excessive livestock pressure whilst promoting light cattle poaching. The site is fairly isolated and human pressure at present is negligible. The number of visitors to the site is minimal but if this increased it would be very damaging. Scrub invasion in parts of the site is also a lesser threat but is being successfully managed through an EN Management Agreement.

Description:

The site comprises a series of springs and associated fen along the lower slopes of Sand Dale, together with Eller's Wood. The springs drain into Thornton Beck which forms the eastern boundary of the wood.

Eller's Wood is a remnant of formerly more extensive broadleaved woodland on the edge of extensive conifer plantations. Situated on the valley floor bordering Thornton Beck it is damp and dominated by large coppiced alders *Alnus glutinosa*. Other tree species include occasional oak *Quercus robur*, ash *Fraxinus excelsior* and sycamore *Acer pseudoplatanus* with an understorey of hazel *Corylus avellana*, holly *Ilex aquifolium* and hawthorn *Crataegus monogyna*. The base rich ground flora in the drier areas contains dog's mercury *Mercurialis perennis*, wood anemone *Anemone nemorosa*, sanicle *Sanicula europaea*, primrose *Primula vulgaris* and locally ramsons *Allium ursinum* and a population of herb paris *Paris quadrifolia*. In the wetter situations species such as marsh marigold *Caltha palustris*, yellow flag *Iris pseudacorus*, remote sedge *Carex remota* and both opposite and alternate-leaved golden saxifrage *Chrysosplenium oppositifolium*, *C. alternifolium* occur.

In Sand Dale rich fen vegetation follows the seepage lines from springs and contains an impressive list of species. Blunt flowered rush *Juncus subnodulosus*, sharp flowered rush *J. acutiflorus*, long-stalked yellow sedge *Carex lepidocarpa* and bryophytes form the basis of the community. Within this area species present include bog pimpernel *Anagallis tenella*, few-flowered spike rush *Eleocharis quinquefora*, black bog rush *Schoenus nigricans*, broad-leaved cotton grass *Eriophorum latifolium*, marsh lousewort *Pedicularis palustris*, grass-of-Parnassus *Parnassia palustris* and fragrant orchid *Gymnadenia conopsea*. An outstanding feature of the fen community is a large population of narrow-leaved marsh orchid *Dactylorhiza traunsteineri* and hybrids.

Between the flushes on raised banks there is a more acidic grassland amongst scattered gorse *Ulex europaeus* and hawthorn *Crataegus monogyna*. Species here include heather *Calluna vulgaris*, bilberry *Vaccinium myrtillus*, tormentil *Potentilla erecta*, wavy hair grass *Deschampsia flexuosa* and mountain everlasting *Antennaria dioica*. To the east of these banks a small area is dominated by purple moor grass *Molinia caerulea* and meadow thistle *Cirsium dissectum*.

A pool near Eller's Wood has recently been re-excavated and supports a fringe of mare's tail *Hippuris vulgaris*.

4.3 Vulnerability

Water levels and flooding are an issue with the River Derwent. Concern has been expressed about both the level of flooding of adjacent agricultural land and also recent flooding of urban areas. This has resulted in public pressure both for new flood defences and different water-level control regimes. Issues relating to water control levels are being addressed through a collaborative project between English Nature, Environment Agency and the water company, Yorkshire Water. English Nature is also fully consulted over any new proposals relating to new or improved flood defences. Water quality is also a potential issue on the river. Improvements are currently proposed under the AMP3 programme.

Description:

The site at Nabgate lies on the steep north-facing slope of Sand Dale on Corallian limestone of the Jurassic series. It is of interest for its species-rich calcareous grassland, developed on thin, stony soils and screes, in an area otherwise extensively afforested.

The grassland is rabbit grazed and dominated by red fescue *Festuca rubra*, crested hair-grass *Koeleria macrantha* and meadow oat-grass *Avenula pratensis* together with quaking-grass *Briza media* and glaucous sedge *Carex flacca*. Typical herbs include mouse-ear hawkweed *Hieracium pilosella*, rough hawkbit *Leontodon hispidus*, common rock-rose *Helianthemum nummularium*, salad burnet *Sanguisorba minor*, wild thyme *Thymus praecox* and saw-wort *Serratula tinctoria* with the uncommon woolly thistle *Cirsium eriophorum*. A large population of fly orchid *Ophrys insectifera* is a feature of the site.

The upper part of the slope and pockets of deeper soil support species such as dropwort *Filipendula vulgaris*, ploughman's spikenard *Inula conyza* and agrimony *Agrimonia eupatoria*.

Small springs give rise to a wet grassland flora including tufted hair-grass *Deschampsia cespitosa*, meadowsweet *Filipendula ulmaria*, wild angelica *Angelica sylvestris* and cuckooflower *Cardamine pratensis*. Areas of scree support large populations of cowslip *Primula veris* and autumn gentian *Gentianella amarella*

There is an element of dry dwarf-shrub heath vegetation in the grassland with scattered clumps of bell heather *Erica cinerea*, heather *Calluna vulgaris*, bilberry *Vaccinium myrtillus*, heath bedstraw *Galium saxatile* and tormentil *Potentilla erecta*. The proportion of this heath vegetation increases towards the site margins, particularly towards the east, where coarser tussocky grassland is characterised by heath-grass *Danthonia decumbens*, common bent *Agrostis capillaris*, crested dog's-tail *Cynosurus cristatus*, Yorkshire-fog *Holcus lanatus* and yellow oat-grass *Trisetum flavescens*. Herbs include ribwort plantain *Plantago lanceolata*, devil's-bit scabious *Succisa pratensis*, common knapweed *Centaurea nigra* and common bird's-foot-trefoil *Lotus corniculatus*.

Hawthorn *Crataegus monogyna* and dog rose *Rosa canina* agg. bushes are scattered over the slope with oak *Quercus* spp., silver birch *Betula pendula*, grey willow *Salix cinerea* and bracken *Pteridium aquilinum* occurring at the site margins.

Description:

These two fen systems lie in the narrow upper reaches of Troutsdale. They display examples of spring and flush fen typical in the local area where base-rich springs emanate from the Corallian Limestone. Such fen systems are nationally rare, being restricted to only four main areas in Norfolk, Oxfordshire, Anglesey and North York Moors. These communities are particularly vulnerable to degradation either by ditching, excess water abstraction or by neglect. Typically the communities exhibit active precipitation and deposition of calcium carbonate in the form of marl and tufa respectively.

Two main plant communities are present at this site. Troutsdale Fen supports a large area of fen meadow dominated by rushes including soft rush *Juncus effusus*, compact rush *J. conglomeratus* and the rarer blunt-flowered rush *J. subnodulosus*. Sedges are well represented, including long-stalked yellow sedge *Carex lepidocarpa*, glaucous sedge *C. flacca* and carnation sedge *C. panicea*, together with wetland herbs such as marsh valerian *Valeriana dioica*, meadowsweet *Filipendula ulmaria* and devil's-bit scabious *Succisa pratensis*. Other herbs of note are meadow thistle *Cirsium dissectum* and several orchid species, including marsh helleborine *Epipactis palustris*. The tall common reed *Phragmites australis* occurs in a few places.

Within Troutsdale Fen the above community grades into a coarser one dominated by tussocks of the black bog rush *Schoenus nigricans*, but this community is more common within the fen to the north-east, known as Rosekirk Dale fen. Typical plants include purple moor-grass *Molinia caerulea*, the insect feeding butterwort *Pinguicula vulgaris*, broad-leaved cotton-grass *Eriophorum latifolium* and common cotton-grass *E. angustifolium*. In places mounds of bog mosses *Sphagnum spp.* allow some plants to grow in a more acidic environment above the influence of the calcareous flushes. Here species more typical of heathland survive such as cross-leaved heath *Erica tetralix*, bilberry *Vaccinium myrtillus*, crowberry *V. vitis-idaea* and crowberry *Empetrum nigrum*.

Small areas of scrub occur within both fen systems and include hawthorn *Crataegus monogyna*, blackthorn *Prunus spinosa* and grey willow *Salix cinerea*.

It is known that calcareous fen systems support distinctive insect faunas. Although this site has not been well studied, it is known that the flush systems are particularly important for soldier flies. A species of crane fly *Limonia occidua*, which is commonly found in Scotland, also occurs at Troutsdale Fen and this is one of the very few English locations for this species.
