Proposed Replacement Fence

Design and Heritage Statement RevA

The development covered in this statement is located around the perimeter of the rear playground

Amount and Scale Statement:

The proposal is to extend and replace the existing school chain link fence and posts with a new weld mesh fence and posts. The new fence will not exceed the current height and will be a dark green colour to match the main school building.

Appearance Statement:

The new fence will appear very similar to the existing except we are proposing a dark green colour. This will help it blend better into the surrounding context.

Heritage Statement:

What is significant about the heritage asset?

The school is prominent building within the local community and has provided education to the village and surrounding areas for over 100 years. The original building is constructed from a stone and slate with detailing above and below the windows and around the roof eaves.

What works are proposed?

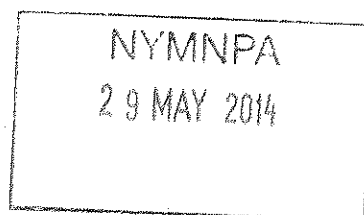
We are proposing to replace the existing chain link fence with a new weld mesh fence. The new fence is to be 2.4m high from the playground floor level.

What impact do the works have on the part of the heritage asset affected?

We believe the proposed impact will be minimal and actually provide a more authentic appearance as the existing chain link fence is galvanised metal and we are proposing to install dark green finished fence to match the school colours but also blend into the surroundings.

How has the impact of the proposals been minimised?

The new fence is replacing the existing and by incorporating a dark green finish this will blend better with the surrounding moorland.
