Assessment of Heritage Significance

The installation of the cattle grid has minimal impact on the farm. The existing gate posts and walls are not going to be altered. Even the old hinge posts will stay

Assessment of impact

The scheme has minimal impact, as the wall and gate posts are unaltered. Some cobbles will be removed in the yard for the installation of the cattle grid. However these were installed recently by the previous owner, so have no significance on the site. The addition of the cattle grid will have a positive impact on the village as visitors will not have to park on the road side while they open and close the gate. This also has an impact on safety as the entrance is fairly close to the sharp bend in the road.

Mitigation Strategy

The original gate will be removed, but the gate posts and hinge brackets remain. The new pedestrian gate and return fence is of a similar agricultural style and made of timber. The cattle grid is made of galvanised iron.
