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The above named Authority being the Planning Authority for the purposes of your application registered 6 April 2010 in respect of proposed development for the purposes of **construction of timber stable block and timber dog kennels at Foulsyke Farm, Fylingdales** have considered your said application and have **granted** permission for the proposed development subject to the following condition(s):

1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of three years from the date of this permission.
2. The development hereby approved shall only be carried out in strict accordance with the detailed specifications and plans comprised in the application hereby approved in accordance with the following drawings



or in accordance with any subsequent minor variation thereof that may be approved by the Local Planning Authority.
3. There shall be no commercial use of the stable or kennels hereby permitted and it shall be used only for the horses and dogs kept for hobby/domestic purposes ancillary to the occupation of the property known as Foulsyke Farm and for no other purpose unless a separate grant of planning permission has first been obtained from the Local Planning Authority.
4. The external elevations of the stables and kennels hereby approved shall, within 3 months of first being brought into use, be clad in horizontal timber boarding, and shall thereafter be so maintained unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Local Planning Authority.

Reasons for Conditions

1. To ensure compliance with Sections 91 to 94 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 as amended.
2. For the avoidance of doubt and to ensure that the details of the development comply with the provisions of NYM Core Policy A and NYM Development Policy 3.

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Reasons for Conditions (Continued)

3. In order to comply with NYM Development Policy 19 which seeks to ensure that proposals for stables are well related to a domestic curtilage and to enable the Local Planning Authority to control any commercial use of the stables which could give rise to conditions detrimental to the special qualities of the National Park and the residential amenities of adjoining occupiers which would be contrary to NYM Core Policy A.
4. For the avoidance of doubt and in order to comply with the provisions of NYM Core Policy A and NYM Development Policy 3 which seek to ensure that the appearance of the development is compatible with the character of the locality and that the special qualities of the National Park are safeguarded.



Reason for Approval
