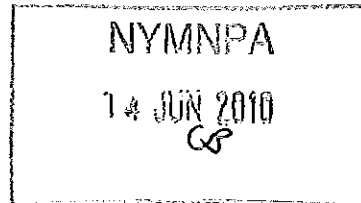

I have registered my objection to the above planning application with the North Yorkshire Planning Authority and was told by AGAST that you also wish to be informed of any objections.

I understand this project has already been refused by yourself to be constructed within the area of the National Park. If Moorland Energy now seeks to place it immediately outside the limits of the National Park area, on land which is designated an area of high value landscape and no less a place of beauty then surely the revised plan should also be rejected.

Seventy years ago I was brought up in the East Midlands, near the coalfields, and was almost daily subject to the odour of gas plants. I would not like to be reminded of those times if our peaceful little village were to be permeated by the stench of sour gas.

Moorland Energy states it would bring employment to the area. I understand the various parts would be manufactured elsewhere and assembled on site. I don't think there are many (if any?) unemployed gas engineers, nor other suitably qualified persons required for the construction of such an installation living in the area and dread to imagine the impact on village life by the importation of 150 construction workers plus members of their families and, once the work is completed the effect they are likely to have on the local unemployment figures? I also fail to see how they can carry out their intention to employ ten apprentices in a total workforce of 20-25, as stated in their Spring 2010 "News Update".

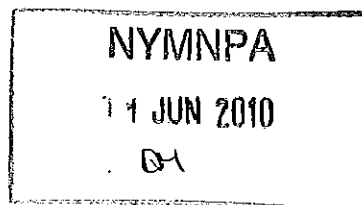
If an international company such as British Petroleum cannot ensure the safety of its pipelines against breakdown, what provisions have Moorland Energy made against a similar possible eventuality? Also what happens if the company were to become bankrupt, who would then be responsible for the security and dismantling of the plant and who will have to cover the cost?

I believe there are viable alternative locations for this facility, eg. the former natural gas processing plant at Pickering; also a disused quarry at Allerston which is closer to the wellhead, well hidden from view and would cause almost no visual impact on the landscape.
