- 2. The development hereby permitted shall not be carried out other than in accordance with the application plans as amended by the letter received at the National Park Authority on the 3 December 2010, or in accordance with any minor variation thereof that may be approved by the Local Planning Authority.
- 3. All new window frames and external door frames shall be finished in cream and shall be maintained in that condition in perpetuity, unless otherwise agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority.
- 4. The external face of the frame to all new windows shall be set in reveals to match those of the existing windows and shall be maintained in that condition in perpetuity unless otherwise agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority.

- 1. To ensure compliance with Sections 91 to 94 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 as amended.
- 2. For the avoidance of doubt and to ensure that the details of the development comply with the provisions of NYM Core Policy A and Development Plan Policy 3.
- 3 & 4. For the avoidance of doubt and in order to comply with the provisions of NYM Core Policy A and NYM Development Policy 3 which seek to ensure that the appearance of the development is compatible with the character of the locality and that the special qualities of the National Park are safeguarded.
