- 2. The development hereby permitted shall not be carried out other than in accordance with the application plans as amended by the plans received by the National Park Authority on 30 June 2011 and the letter received on 30 June 2011, or in accordance with any minor variation thereof that may be approved by the Local Planning Authority.
- 3. The roof of the development hereby permitted shall be clad with traditional, handmade natural red clay pantiles and shall be maintained in that condition in perpetuity, unless otherwise agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority.
- 4. No work shall commence on the installation of any replacement or new windows in the development hereby approved until detailed plans showing the constructional details of all window frames to be used in the development have been submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. Such plans should indicate, on a scale of not less than 1:20, the longitudinal and cross sectional detailing including means of opening. The window frames shall be installed in accordance with the approved details and shall be maintained in that condition in perpetuity unless otherwise agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority.
- 5. All new window frames and glazing bars shall be of timber construction and white painted and shall be maintained in that condition in perpetuity, unless otherwise agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority.

- 1. To ensure compliance with Sections 18(1) of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 as amended.
- 2. For the avoidance of doubt and to ensure that the details of the development comply with the provisions of NYM Core Policy A and Development Plan Policy 3.
