The above named Authority being the Planning Authority for the purposes of your application registered 25 August 2011, in respect of proposed development for the purposes of erection of a 15 kW wind turbine (maximum height 20.9 metres to blade tip) at Spikers Hill Farm, Cockrah Road, West Ayton have considered your said application and have granted permission for the proposed development subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of three years from the date of this permission.
- The development hereby permitted shall not be carried out other than in accordance with the application plans as amended by the plans received at the National Park Authority on the 14 September 2011, or in accordance with any minor variation thereof that may be approved by the Local Planning Authority.
- 3. If the use of the turbine hereby approved permanently ceases, it shall be removed from the land within one year of that cessation and the land shall, as far as practical, be restored to its condition before development took place.

Reasons for Conditions

- 1. To ensure compliance with Sections 91 to 94 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 as amended.
- 2. For the avoidance of doubt and to ensure that the details of the development comply with the provisions of NYM Core Policy A and Development Plan Policy 3.
- 3. For the avoidance of doubt and to comply with NYM Core Policy A and Development Policies, which seek to ensure that, development does not have an unacceptable impact on the wider landscape.
