Subject: NYM/2011/0757/FL erect temporary drilling rig, access arrangements etc, Langdale Rigg End

Proposal: erect temporary potash drilling rig, access arrangements etc
Address: Langdale Rigg End, Langdale Forest

The above application has been considered by Council. While there are no objections, Council wishes to comment as follows:-

- All access roads and tracks should, as an absolute minimum, be left in the same state of repair as they were found - ideally they should be left in a better state of repair.
- As much traffic as possible (including staff) should enter the site from the A169 - this should also include the water tanker deliveries (which are currently shown as entering via Langdale End and West Side Brow). This will minimise the impact of the works and protect residents from unnecessary interference.
- It is requested the applicants carry out the proposed Derwent Head drilling prior to moving to Langdale Rigg End - this is due to the difficulties which can be encountered on the Langdale Rigg End road during the winter months by residents.

Concerns were also expressed by the occupiers of High Langdale End Farm that they had not been informed of this application (which was within 400 metres of their property) yet had been told about the application at Derwent Head Rigg 4km. distant !!
