Heath Cottage and The

House and shop, early-mid C19. Fine herringbone-tooled coursed sandstone; pantiled roof with stone kneeler and stack. 3 storeys, 2 bays. At left a Victorian shop front with fancy bracketed cornice; at right a door of 4 fielded panels and a late C19 sash form a shop front under continuous bracketed cornice. Small fixed lights at right and left and a boarded outhouse door at extreme left. First floor two 16-pane sashes, second floor two 24-pane Yorkshire sashes, all with vertically-tooled lintels and cills. Chimney and prominent curved kneeler at right end. Right return blank but for small loft window at extreme right.

House to south of

House, circa 1700 with alterations. Very lightly tooled, unevenly-coursed sandstone, the lower coursed thicker; basement rendered. Renewed pantiled roof with stone kneelers and ridge stack. Gable end to road 3 storeys and basement, 2 bays. Modern basement window, 12-pane sash on ground floor, very small 4-pane sash in chamfered opening on first floor and two 6-pane sashes in lengthened older openings, on second floor. Stack at gable peak. Entrance front is left return. Left 6-panel door in doorcase of reeded pilasters and open-pedimented hood; shaped stone lintel with initials E and AS. Right wide 28-pane fixed light with small off-centre opening section. First floor right casement set in old chamfered opening, left 16-pane sash; 12-pane sash above. Traces of earlier, shorter openings.
