The cobbled boat storage area is in The Dock in Robin Hoods Bay & is in the village conservation area.	The proposal is to fit removable wooden bollards on both sides of The Dock where the boat storage area meets the public highway. The bollards will sit inside a concrete recess & will be removable. The bollards will project 1 metre above ground.	The bollards will replace, on the north side of The Dock, round metal removable posts that do not match anything else in the village. The posts on the south side of The Dock will match in design the ones that currently border the old lifeboat shelter. I cannot imagine that they will have any impact.	The proposed bollards have been sourced from the same sawmill to the same design as the bollards that have been supplied by NYMNPA rangers to replace the warn bollards surrounding the old lifeboat shelter.  Whitby Stoneworking, who have laid many cobbles in the village on NYMNPA projects have been selected to carry out the installation. They will make good the cobbles round the new posts.
