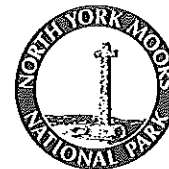

## Notification under Part 7, Class A of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 for proposed improvement works to forest track and turning point at Ellerburn Road, Low Dalby Village

Thank you for your notification under the above Order, which was received at the National Park Office on 10 April 2012.

I am writing, on behalf of the National Park Authority, to advise you that approval your proposal proposed improvement works to forest track and turning point at Ellerburn Road Low Dalby Village, as shown on the submitted plans, has been approved subject to the following informative(s):

1. The existing Public Right(s) of Way on the site must be protected and kept clear of any obstruction until such time as any alternative route has been provided and confirmed under an Order made under the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. Applicants are advised to contact the North York Moors National Park Authority, Public Rights of Way Officer at The Old Vicarage, Bondgate, Helmsley on 01439 772700 to obtain up-to-date information regarding the line of the route of the way. The applicant should discuss with the Highway Authority any proposals for altering the route.
2. The applicant is advised that the track works are close to a feature recorded on the North York Moors HER (HER 8111.01043 trap: rabbit). As yet, no remains have been identified on the ground but potential features should be respected. The applicants/contractors are advised to contact the North York Moors Archaeologist at The Old Vicarage, Bondgate, Helmsley on 01439 772700 for further information.

The work must be carried out in accordance with the detailed specifications and plans comprised in the notification hereby approved and within five years of the date of this letter, otherwise a new formal notification will be required.
