Re Application for non-material amendment to planning approval NYM/2012/0200/FL

We write as owners of 2 Esk Terrace, Egton Bridge, YO21 1 1XA.

We write to formally object to the above revised proposal. We did not object to the original proposal for locating a garden shed in this location and would maintain that position if the shed was of a conventional size. However what is being proposed in this amended application is the erection of a **huge** shed. The proposed ridge at 2.5 meters would be substantially higher than the existing wooden fence and would therefore obscure the view of the river and the surrounding embankment from the footpath area and Esk Terrace itself . It would significantly detract from the visual amenity in a popular visitor location within the Park and could only have a detrimental impact on the natural beauty and character of the location.

We would stress once again that we would have no objection to a more conventionally sized wooden shed which would be obscured by the existing wooden fence.
