To whom it may concern:

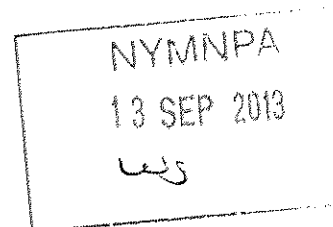
I am a resident in the North York Moors National Park and wholeheartedly support Mr Bob Walker in his application for a private airstrip.

I feel that the application decision will be based on the negative objections based on the horror of some of the local residents who will object but who do not understand the minimal impact this will have on the local environment.
