- 3. Within one month of the shipping container hereby approved being brought onto site it shall be clad in dark brown stained timber vertical boarding and dark brown or grey pitched roof, and thereafter be maintained in that condition in perpetuity unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Local Planning Authority.
- 4. Prior to the siting of any additional picnic benches details of their numbers and location shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority.
- 5. If the use of the development hereby permitted ceases, the structures and rope walk ways shall be removed from the land and the land shall, so far as is practicable, be restored to its condition before development took place.


