Further to our letter of objection to the above we wish
to add this addendum.
my wife, family and I have lived in R-sward for
over 30 years.

During the early years, commercial activities have
been in harmony with the residents, being two small
garages, the cattle mart and agricultural store a
small joinery and builders premises, adjacent, and
a furniture store/warehouse to the east (nearby
Service Station). (West W. Noble Yard)

The majority still exist and were welcome in our
community. However when W. Noble arrived they
have spread unchecked like a cancer across the
area adjacent to the East seemingly without regard
for planning approval in regard of noise, dust and
the environmental health requirements for burning
of toxic materials and the prevailing wind carrying
fine clouds to the East over the properties there.

Recently (not W. Noble) they have started to produce
large concrete blocks adjacent to Knowlton CAFE.
Primary School - using cement products with toxic
dust and excessive noise during the day permeating
the village air. Scarborough Councils domain fear!

W. Noble are and always have appeared to do just
what they like, regardless of local objections.

We therefore appeal to the N.Y.M. Natl Park Authority
- Should this application be granted in any way - to
rigorously apply controls and conditions there - to in
the future stop this further but on our face
lovely village.
