Dear Sir/Madam,

I am unable to speak at the above meeting on 18/6/15 but would like to log my objection to the retention of farm buildings which have been erected without planning consent.

I understand Mr Temple, the tenant farmer, is blocked from keeping pigs and poultry in the buildings. The non-degradable debris thrown from the buildings down the steep slope to the stream is a dreadful eyesore and is a pointer to the way in which this farmer disregards both his neighbours and the environment. This behaviour is unacceptable anywhere but it is a violation in a National Park and negates his right to have his retrospective application favoured. Additionally, there may be issues with organic animal waste which may flow

from the sheds down the steep slope into the stream.
