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
The above named Authority being the Planning Authority for the purposes of your application validated 09 February 2015, in respect of proposed development for the purposes of **variation of condition 4 of planning approval NYM/2014/0709/FL to allow the use of wood grain effect uPVC framing at Highgate Howe Holiday Home Park, Hawsker** has considered your said application and has **granted** permission for the proposed development subject to the following conditions:

1. The development hereby permitted shall be commenced before the expiration of three years from the date of this permission.
2. The development hereby approved shall be only carried out in strict accordance with the detailed specifications and plans comprised in the application hereby approved or in accordance with any minor variation thereof that may be approved by the Local Planning Authority.
3. All new stonework used in the development hereby permitted shall match that of the existing building including the colour and texture of the stone and the method of coursing and pointing unless otherwise agreed with the Local Planning Authority.
4. No work shall commence to install the windows and doors in the development hereby approved until details of the colour/finish of the windows and doors has been submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The work shall be completed in accordance with the approved details within six months of being installed and shall be maintained in that condition in perpetuity unless otherwise agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority.

Reasons for Conditions

1. To ensure compliance with Sections 91 to 94 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 as amended.
2. For the avoidance of doubt and to ensure that the details of the development comply with the provisions of NYM Core Policy A and NYM Development Policy 3, which seek to conserve and enhance the special qualities of the NYM National Park.
3. For the avoidance of doubt and in order to comply with the provisions of NYM Core Policy A and NYM Development Policy 3 which seek to ensure that building materials are of a high quality and compatible with the character of the locality and that the special qualities of the National Park are safeguarded.


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Reasons for Conditions (Continued)
