3. Description of Proposed Works

Please describe the proposals to alter, extend or demolish the listed building(s):

Internally structural works on the first floor are to include opening up an existing fireplace and removing the wall in the lobby. Structural works to the first floor; walls to be taken out, bathrooms to be stripped, new walls to be formed and a new en suite and bathroom to be formed.

On the ground floor the joinery details are to include, removing the wall in the lobby to replace with new glazed screen detail and new door. The existing bar tops are to be repolished and the existing panelling to the bar area will receive a new paint finish. The back bar and over bar bulkhead will receive the same; sanding and a full repolish. Upstairs joinery work is minimal and consist of creating built in hanging rails to bedrooms and fitted dressing tables.

The existing fixed seating is to be retained and recovered, with one section being cut back. New sections of fixed seating and booth will be added to the family room. The existing fireplace to the family room will be upgraded to an open fire. New tiles will also added to bring this in with the new scheme and the fireplace in the bar area will be opened up to match family room.

The toilets are to strip out all redundant fixtures, fittings and finishes including flooring, wall tiles, existing vanity unit & sanitary ware. Then receive full internal decorations with new half height tiles in the ladies and full height wall tiles in the gents to the gents. New WC's are to be fitted to both ladies and gents with new pod urinals also being installed to the gents toilets. New lighting will be also be fitted.

The site is to have new flooring throughout, this will consist of timber in the bar area, timber and carpet to the family room, entrance matting in both lobby's, tiles to the ground floor corridor, then carpets to all stairs and bedrooms 5 & 6 upstairs and altro to any new bathroom and back of house areas as well as kitchenette area in manager's accommodation

On the ground floor most of the existing furniture is to be refurbished with some new elements. Also lighting, curtains and decorations will be added to the scheme. Most of the bric a brac will be local history. The first floor will have full decorations to letting rooms, and new furniture will be added to rooms 5 & 6 as the existing will be reused
