Retrospective consent for the installation of a soil stack and ancillary pipe work for two toilets along with two smaller waste pipes for a shower and sink. I have spoken with Mr Edward Freedman who is willing to support my application providing the material of the stack is changed. My proposal is to remove the plastic stack and replace it, like for like, with a 'Cast iron Style' installation, this will allow minimal disruption to the internal pipe work along with the ability to connect to the soil stack socket concreted into the ground.

This type of installation is widely used in heritage properties and provides affordability along with safety in installation.
