

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The above named Authority being the Planning Authority for the purposes of your application validated 10 December 2015, in respect of proposed development for the purposes of **variation of condition 2 (material amendment) of planning approval NYM/2014/0803/FL to allow the replacement of rooflights with 2 no. dormer windows at Coachmans Cottage, Aislaby** has considered your said application and has **granted** permission for the proposed development subject to the following conditions:

1. The development hereby approved shall be only carried out in strict accordance with the detailed specifications and plans comprised in the application hereby approved or in accordance with any minor variation thereof that may be approved by the Local Planning Authority.
2. All new stonework and roofing tiles used in the development hereby permitted shall match those of the existing building, including the colour and texture of the stone and the method of coursing, pointing, jointing and mortar mix unless otherwise agreed with the Local Planning Authority.
3. All pointing in the development hereby permitted shall accord with the following specification - a lime mortar mix of 1:2½ (lime; sand (sand mix of 50% sieved sharp sand and 50% builder's sand) with a slightly recessed bagged finish.
4. All new window frames, glazing bars, external doors and door frames shall be of timber construction and shall be maintained in that condition in perpetuity unless otherwise agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority.
5. The external face of the frame to all new windows shall be set in a reveal of a minimum of 150mm from the front face of the adjacent walling and shall be maintained in that condition in perpetuity unless otherwise agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority.

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Conditions (Continued)


6. No work shall commence to stain/paint the windows and doors in the development hereby approved until details of the paint colour/finish of the windows and doors has been submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The work shall be completed in accordance with the approved details within six months of being installed and shall be maintained in that condition in perpetuity unless otherwise agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority.
7. The rooflights proposed shall match those of the existing rooflights in terms of the manufacturer, model, scale and projection unless otherwise agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority.
8. The rainwater goods utilised in the development hereby permitted shall be coloured black and shall thereafter be so maintained in that condition in perpetuity unless otherwise agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority.

Reasons for Conditions

1. For the avoidance of doubt and to ensure that the details of the development comply with the provisions of NYM Core Policy A and NYM Development Policy 3, which seek to conserve and enhance the special qualities of the NYM National Park.
- 2 & 3. For the avoidance of doubt and in order to comply with the provisions of NYM Core Policy A and NYM Development Policy 3 which seek to ensure that building materials are of a high quality and compatible with the character of the locality and that the special qualities of the National Park are safeguarded.
- 4 – 8. For the avoidance of doubt and in order to comply with the provisions of NYM Core Policy A and NYM Development Policy 3 which seek to ensure that the appearance of the development is compatible with the character of the locality and that the special qualities of the National Park are safeguarded.
