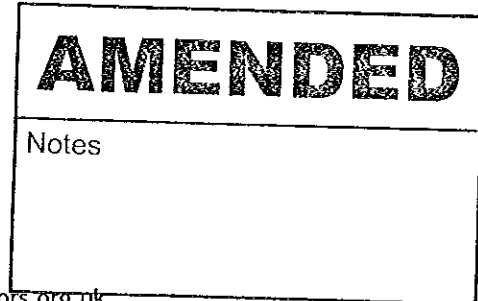

Hi Helen and may thanks for your letter dated the 10th February 2016. We have taken on board your comments and that of the Parish Council and Highways. The original preferred location was an extension to the Parish Council Notice Board, however we received a clear message back from the PC that they did not want it incorporation into the same notice board.

Having spoken to the owners of the Post Office, whose land it is to be sited, they have agreed to it being fixed on a pole situated at the end of the short wall to the right hand side of the Parish Council's Notice board, as shown on the attached plan and photograph. This would certainly address the congestion objections raised.

It is proposed that the Touch Screen now be positions on the same angle as the wall. The measurement from the roadside kerb to the post box is presently 2m and the touch Screen will be a further 2.5m inset, making a total of 4.5m from the kerb to the centre of the screen. However since the touch screen would be pointing at a sharp angle down the road, it would effectively be some 50m away from oncoming traffic and the lumen level would therefore have diminished to a fraction of that emitted from the headlights of oncoming vehicles and that of Highways permitted level, when measured at the kerb.

We did consider siting the screen to the right of the Post Office entrance door, but the wall is too narrow and we felt too greater distance. The new preferred position is grouped together with the local events notice board and the Parish Council's notice board, keeping all local and tourist information in one place.

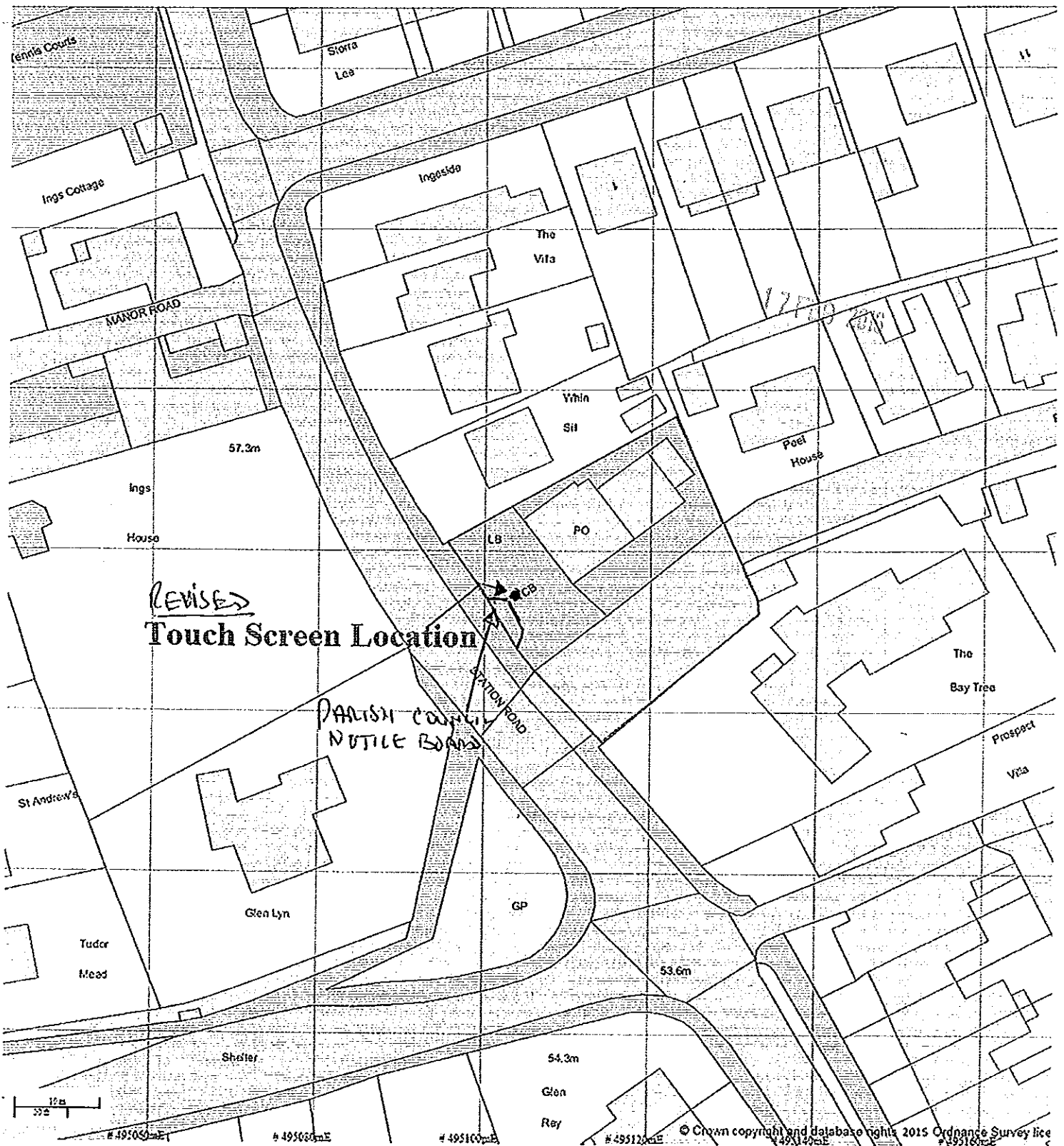
I trust this amendment meets with approval; time is of the essence, as the Touch Screen has to installed and working by the end of March, in order to receive the Grant funding from NYMNP.
