

Application Under Section 96A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 for non material amendment to planning approval NYM/2015/0033/FL to allow alterations to roof design, relocation of approved flue pipe and omission of chimney at Glen Farm, 3 The Cliff, Iburndale

Thank you for your application validated 29 July 2016, regarding the above.

I am writing, on behalf of the National Park Authority, to advise you that the amendments outlined above and as shown on the submitted plans have been approved, subject to the following provisions:

- Notwithstanding the details of the approved plans to NYM/2015/0033/FL, this
 permission permits the change to allow alterations to roof design, relocation of
 approved flue pipe and omission of chimney. The development shall accord in all other
 respects with the approved plans and imposed conditions on planning permission
 NYM/2015/0033/FL.
- 2. All flues associated with the proposed development shall be coloured matt black and maintained in that condition in perpetuity unless otherwise agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority.

Informative

The proposed development lies within a coal mining area which may contain unrecorded mining related hazards. If any coal mining feature is encountered during development, this should be reported to The Coal Authority. Any intrusive activities which disturb or enter any coal seams, coal mine workings or coal mine entries (shafts and adits) requires the prior written permission of The Coal Authority.
