
Thank you for your application validated 02 December 2016, regarding the above.

I am writing, on behalf of the National Park Authority, to advise you that the amendments outlined above and as shown on the submitted plans have been approved, subject to the following provision:

1. The development hereby approved shall only be carried out in accordance with the amended plans which comprise the realignment of the internal access road and amendment to drill pad level above AoD as shown on drawing number YP-P10-DNF-CX-007 & 008 and accompanying written specification received on 1st December 2016. Otherwise the development shall be carried out completely in accordance with the approved plans and imposed conditions of planning approval NYM/2014/0676/MEIA. These changes shall be taken into account for future submissions to meet other conditional requirements including conditions relating to noise (18,19, 20,21, 24 & 25).
